


	<p>September 1—Animal Tracks & Signs: There are many animal-made signs in the woods that reveal who has been using the trail before you. Become a nature detective and search for some animal tracks, scat and signs in the Nature Preserve.</p> <p><i>*This program will be a hike.</i></p>
<p>September 7—Biodiversity Day!: Come out to celebrate California Biodiversity and observe nature at Effie Yeaw with California state partners and community members!</p> <p><i>*This program is FREE and runs 9am–12pm.</i></p>	<p>September 8—Plants with Purpose: Walk with a naturalist through the nature center's garden. Learn plant identification and adaptations.</p>  <p><i>*This program will be a small walk.</i></p>
<p>September 14—River Walk: Celebrate the beauty of nature with a guided walk through the Nature Preserve and down to the American River.
